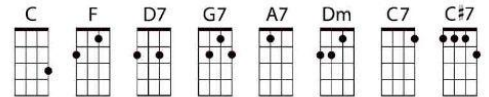


I Want a Ukulele for Christmas - John Meola Lindhorst

[D7]but for me, only a [G7]ukulele

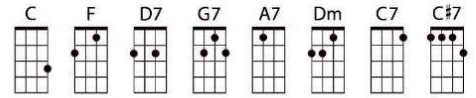
