


Coney Island Washboard Rondelay - Durand, Adams, Nestor, Shugart (1926)

Each chord = 4 counts

[G7!] = 1 short strum

//, // = Charleston strum

Strum = 

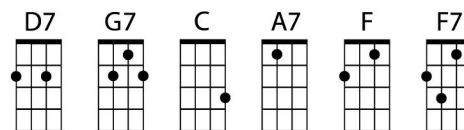
Intro: [D7] //// [G7] //// [C] //// [C] //// *slide whistle*

Verse 1: [C] Coney Island [C] washboard she would [A7] play, [A7]
She'd [D7] play it on the [D7] boardwalk every [D7] day [D7]

Tiny [C] bubbles on the [A7] ground
