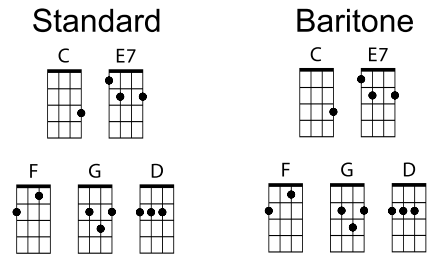


Old Home Place - Webb & Jayne
