



Post-Chorus 1 - echo response where underlined - Lines 18 and 19

Verse 3 - melody only


Bridge - Harmony # 1 - Lines 23 and 24

Chorus 2 - Harmonies # 2 - using "Ahhs" - Starting Line 26 through 32




