

Articles of Incorporation for Salt Lake Strummers

Article I: Name - The name of this nonprofit organization shall be Salt Lake Strummers.

Article II: Purpose - The purpose of the Salt Lake Strummers is to provide a welcoming and supportive community for ukulele players of all skill levels in the Salt Lake area. The organization aims to promote the enjoyment of music, foster skill development, and create opportunities for musical collaboration and performance in the community.

Article III: Nonprofit Status - Salt Lake Strummers is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and community-oriented purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IV: Duration - The duration of Salt Lake Strummers shall be perpetual unless dissolved according to the provisions outlined in these Articles of Incorporation or as required by applicable Utah nonprofit laws.

Article V: Registered Office and Agent - Salt Lake Strummers shall maintain a registered office within the state of Utah. The initial registered office shall be located at [REDACTED]. The organization shall also appoint a registered agent who resides at the registered office and is authorized to accept legal notices and process on behalf of Salt Lake Strummers.

Article VI: Board of Directors - Salt Lake Strummers shall be governed by a Board of Directors consisting of individuals who are passionate about the organization's mission. The initial Board shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Member-at-Large. The Board shall have the authority to manage and oversee the affairs of the organization, including but not limited to strategic planning, financial management, and program development.

Article VII: Membership - Salt Lake Strummers shall have a membership open to all individuals interested in ukulele playing, regardless of their skill level or background. Membership benefits may include enhanced access to workshops, performances, social events, and other activities organized by the organization.

Article VIII: Amendments - These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, provided that any proposed amendments are consistent with the organization's nonprofit status and purpose.

Article IX: Governance - The Salt Lake Strummers shall be governed by these Articles and the bylaws of the organization. The bylaws of the organization shall be in conformance with the Utah Nonprofit Corporation Act.

Article X: Dissolution - In the event of the dissolution of Salt Lake Strummers, any remaining assets shall be distributed to one or more nonprofit organizations with similar missions, as determined by the Board of Directors at the time of dissolution.

These Articles of Incorporation have been adopted by the initial Board of Directors of Salt Lake Strummers.
