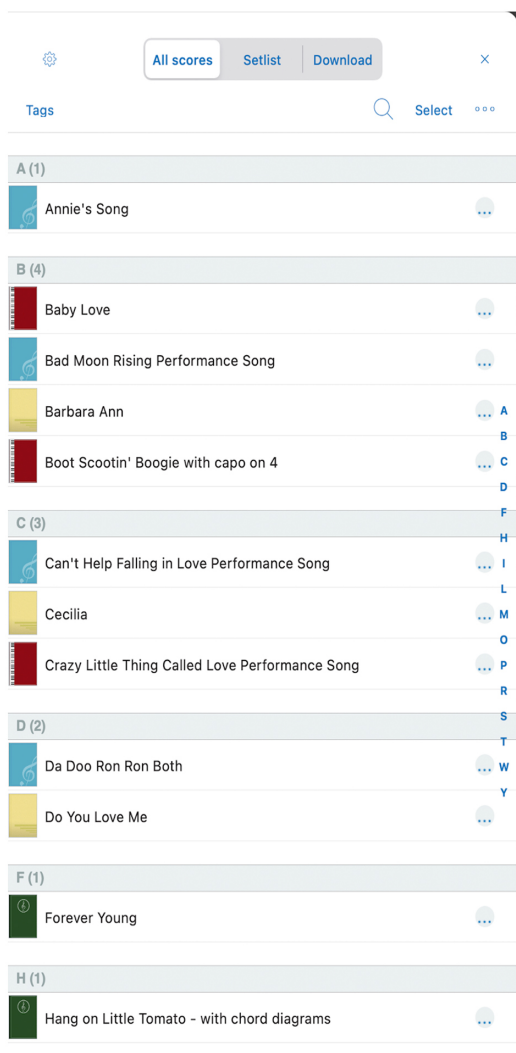


How to Use Piascore - Main Page Overview

When you open Piascore the first time, you will see some old songs with book icons by them. It's free music. If you swipe left on the title, you will see an option to delete.

The 3 boxes located at the top are the most important to understand ALL SCORES is where ALL of your songs are stored. SETLIST is a holding place where you can create a list of songs based on your needs (jam, practice, etc) and they draw from your ALL SCORES and can be used in more than one Setlist. DOWNLOAD is to download items from your drives/cloud.



The little gear is your settings function. You can recover anything you have deleted, connect a foot pedal for page turning, change your background, set up your Apple pencil, change the brightness and pay for the upgraded version if you prefer.

The magnifying glass is to search for songs by keyword or title.

SELECT allows you to select multiple songs at once to delete them, change their book cover, put them into a category using Tags (maybe you want all your Beatles songs tagged). You can also create a setlist and there is an easier way using SETLIST. Press CANCEL when finished.

The 3 dot ellipse is to sort songs by RECENT, TITLE or ARTIST. You can also see your song list when in ALL SCORES mode by GRID or LIST.

There is also a 3 dot ellipse by the title of the song. This is where you can edit the title, the book image, add Artist's name, and tag plus many other listed items. This is where you can also start to mail, print or bluetooth a song to someone else.

To do the above to multiple songs at once, from ALL SCORES, tap on SELECT. Tap on songs all by the same Artist (Beatles are easy) then click on EDIT and choose which item you want to do. For Artists, click on the PLUS sign add the Artists' name. Click SAVE and when you click on the 3 ellipses by SELECT, click on Artists, and you will see all of your songs listed by Artists,

From that open lists of Beatles songs, choose SELECT again, click on the dot at the top left to select all songs, then EDIT. Choose BOOK COVER this time and go find a fun photo of the Beatles or choose a color from the library that suits you. It's best to go find your photo off the internet before you start this one. Close the X to get out.

Downloading Songs from the Internet (outside resources)

The only files that can be stored on Piascore are PDFs.

Every website acts differently and every iPad acts differently based on the age, version, size, etc. If one of the following techniques does not work, try another one.

Go to saltlakestrummers.org and choose a song off the next jam library (you may already have it but that's okay). Click on the title you would like and it should open into a full window. Then click on the download box (looks like a box with an up arrow). You should see the Piascore app icon appear and tap on it. The song is now in your ALL SCORES. If you can find it, try search or look by RECENT under the 3 ellipses at the top.

If that didn't work, try these steps:

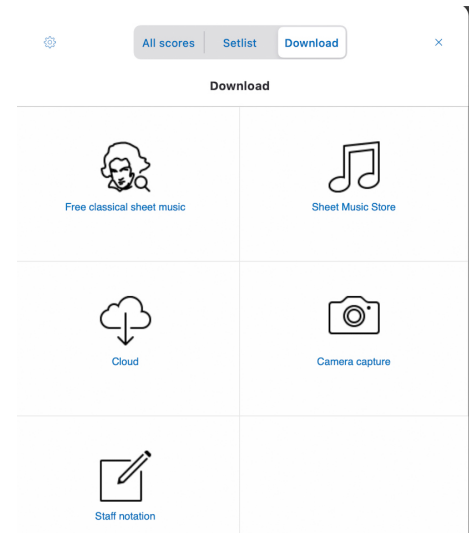
1. If you see a box that says, OPTIONS, and don't see the Piascore app, change the option to PDF then click DONE. You should now see the Piascore app. If not, tap on SAVE TO FILES. The song will now go to your FILES and ON MY IPAD will pop up on the left hand side. When you tap on that, the Piascore folder will now appear. Tap on the folder and tap on SAVE. Now go to ALL SCORES and search for the song using the magnifying glass or RECENT in the 3 ellipses at the top right.

Some sites like Dr. Uke, have a little download arrow. His is at the top right corner of the song. Clicking on the download opens the song to full page then click on the box with the arrow and you should see the Piascore app.

The biggest help is looking for some type of download button or using the OPTIONS if that pops up.

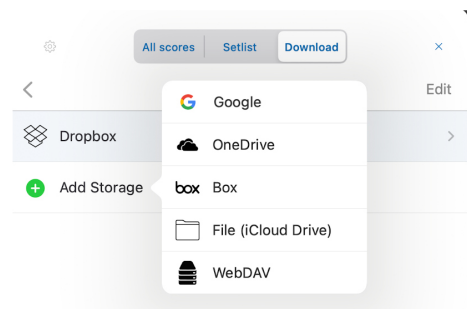
After you have opened a song, tap the middle of the screen and a CATALOG button with left arrow will take you back to where you started.

Downloading Songs from Your iCloud & Drives (your storage)



The two frequently used spots on the DOWNLOAD page are CLOUD and CAMERA CAPTURE.

For CLOUD, you can add apps that store data for you already such as Google Drive, Dropbox, Box, or files from your Folders on your Cloud Drive.

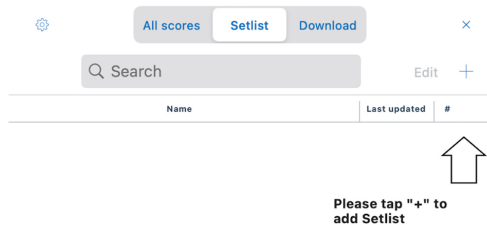


To use CAMERA CAPTURE, take a photo of the hard copy of music. Tap on CAMERA CAPTURE and then ALBUM. Tap on RECENTS and then tap on the song you just took a photo of. If there is more than 1 page, tap on the photos in the order you want them to land. Click on the plus sign, tap SAVE and name your song. Choose color or black and white and then you will go back to DOWNLOADS. Find your download from ALL SCORES using the magnifying glass or look under RECENTS.

Creating Setlists

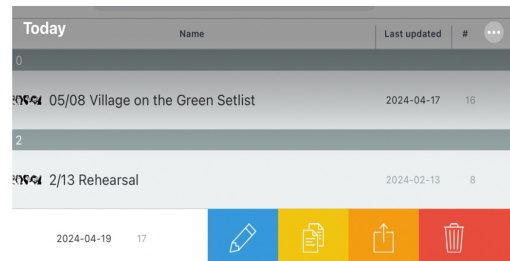
Setlists are a good way to group songs together that you need for a certain reason. It may be a jam, set of songs you are learning, performance songs, songs you play with a group of friends, etc.

To make a setlist, the first time the screen will look like this which is prompting you to click on the plus sign to get started. Every new setlist starts with the plus sign.



You now name your setlist and it can be changed later one. then tap on SAVE. It will close and now re-open it and tap on EDIT. Your full library of ALL SCORES will appear by RECENT, TITLE, ARTIST OR TAGS. By they way, Tags could be something like "MY FAVORITES" or "CHRISTMAS SONGS" When you tap on the song, it will add it to your open setlist on the left. No worries if you madea mistake, swipe, tap the minus button then DELETE. Once the setlist is final, tap on SAVE.You can go back and ADD and DELETE songs as much as you would like. You can move them around while in the EDIT mode by dragging on the hamburger. When you delete a song from setlist, it does not delete it from ALL SCORES. You can use the same song in many different setlists - it doesn't duplicate the song, it draws from the ALL SCORES library each time it is used.

From the location where you can see all of your setlists, if you swipe left, you will get a rainbow of options. You can EDIT (blue) the setlist, you can DUPLICATE the setlist (yellow), you can FORWARD (orange) the entire setlist to someone nearby or over email (more about that later) or DELETE (red) the chosen setlist



Sending Music to Others

In the same room

1. Bluetooth & Airdrop must be on for everyone
2. Open the song to be sent
3. Tap the middle of the screen
4. Hurry and tap the circled i info button
5. Tap on Mail/Print
6. If you have written notes that the other person wants, choose A PDF FILE WITH WRITING. If not, choose PDF FILE ONLY.
7. Tap on SHARE, PRINT, MAIL
8. The Airdrop icon should appear and tap on that.
9. Tap on the person you are sending to, If you don't see the person, check to see if their Airdrop for EVERYONE is on.
10. Click done

Enhancements

When you tap in the middle of the screen when a song is open, icons appear at the bottom and left side of the page. These icons are explained below and can help with your musicality and performance.



1 - Gestures = wink or move your face to one side to make a page turn on a song that has multiple pages

2 - Bookmark = bookmark pages within a songbook that has multi pages

3 - Adjust page = make a page larger or smaller

4 - Pages = set a song with multiple pages to show in a side by side view or to scroll at a pace you set

5 - Info = Place to edit the title of a song, add keywords, tags, artists or drop to someone else, print or email

6 - Performance = tapping this locks your music so the icons won't pop up. To undo, tap the blue X at the top right of the chart

7 - Writing = Various functions appear to be able to type text, write text, erase, highlight, make musical notation, etc.

8 - Music = Tie a recording you made using the Recording function (number 11) or a song from your Apple library to the song so you can listen or play along

9 - Piano keyboard - Use it like a piano

10 - Tuning fork - to tune (use if you have a good ear for pitch)

11 - Recording function = press the start button and record the song that is showing. The song stays until you delete it

12 - Metronome = find the pace you want to play the song or the pace given to you by a leader. Tap to set or tap over and over to find the pace you want to go. The set speed will stay with the song even if you change it on another song.
